- Administer first aid for minor wounds
- Apply infection control procedures
- Manage a casualty with external bleeding
- Manage a casualty suffering shock
- Administer aid for burns and electric shock
- Administer aid for eye and soft tissue injuries
- Manage a casualty suffering near drowning
- Manage a casualty suffering head injuries
